

2015 SUMC WORKCAMP REGISTRATION & COVENANT

Destination: Charlotte, NY

Dates: Sunday, July 26 – Saturday, August 1, 2015

I understand and agree:

- That the number of available places is limited and are filled on a first-come, first-served basis
 - That the 2 deposits reserving my place are non-refundable. If I register and then withdraw, my money will be returned only if a camper is found or taken from the waitlist to take my place:
 - 1st Deposits -\$75 SUMC members; \$100 non-members.
 - 2nd Deposit -\$50 members/ \$75 non-members (amt may increase to 1st deposit amt if needed)
 - That I am expected to contribute at least 40 hours of my time toward fundraising, service and fellowship events in order to prepare for this Workcamp experience:
 1. At least 30 of the hours must be worked by me, of which at least 20 must be worked at Workcamp-related events. The other 10 may be worked at Workcamp or other community service events.
 2. Ten hours may be worked FOR ME by family or friends.
 3. By March 17, 2015 I must have worked and reported at least 15 of the 30 hours referenced in #1, or my Workcamp place may be forfeited without refund of deposit.
 4. For any hours I am short on July 19, 2015, I will pay \$15 per hour prior to departing for Charlotte.
 - **That I am expected to participate in various fundraising to cover my fair share of the cost of the trip (approximately \$450/ per camper after deposits and contribution from SUMC Missions)**
 - That in the unlikely possibility our fundraising projects do not meet our expenses, I may be asked to contribute an additional amount.
 - That monthly meeting attendance is mandatory, and that I, and as often as possible a parent/guardian, will attend scheduled Workcamp meetings during the year. **If I am unable to attend a meeting, a parent or other representative will attend in my place.** Three absences are allowed. If you are represented by a family member, you are not considered absent. For each absence over 3, a \$15 fee will be assessed and must be paid prior to trip departure.
 - That at all times Workcamp preparation and participation is connected with the Shenendehowa United Methodist Church. As a part of Workcamp, I am a laborer of God and Jesus Christ and will exemplify this in my conduct and appropriate attire.
 - That I will abide by the Group Workcamp Living Requirements:
 - a. Lights out at 11:00 p.m.
 - b. No use or possession of alcohol, illegal drugs or weapons
 - c. No smoking or using tobacco indoors or at worksites
 - d. No guys in the girls' area and no girls in the guys' area
 - e. Refrain from using cell phones, radios, cds or tape players except as permitted by SUMC adult leaders
 - f. Avoid sexual indiscretion at all times
 - g. If you are under 21, you may not leave the school premises without an adult leader.
